Police are seeking the publics help in locating the suspect in the abduction of a juvenile female.

On Monday, August 2, 2010, Duluth Police responded to the report that a juvenile female had been abducted in the area of 70th Avenue West and Raleigh Street. The girl told police that at about 3 p.m. she was out walking her dog when a white male in a light colored passenger car pulled over and opened the hood and trunk of his car as if he were having car problems. After a brief conversation the girl was abducted and the male drove her to a location just off of Highway 23 near the Spruce Trail entrance to Jay Cooke State Park. This area is about one mile south of the Mont Du Lac Recreation/Ski Area on Highway 23. After a short time the girl became separated from the suspect and was able to walk to a local business and the police were called.

The suspect is described as a white male in his 20's or 30's, thin build, with a short black "spike" styled haircut, and wearing a dark colored shirt. He was driving a light colored passenger car.

Police are looking for anyone that may have seen the vehicle or the suspect in these areas between 2:30 pm and 6 pm yesterday, Monday, August 2^d, or anyone with any information that may be related to this abduction. They are asked to call the Duluth Police Department at (218) 730-5070.

Also assisting in the investigation is the Carlton County Sheriff's Office, Douglas County Sheriff's Department, the St. Louis County Sheriff's Office, and the Federal Bureau of Investigation.
