The Duluth Police Department, Duluth Fire Department and Superior, WI Police Department are continuing to investigate a series of recent fires in the Twin Ports area that have been determined to be arson. The Duluth Police/Fire Departments specifically have 10 arson cases under investigation that are similar to each other.

A suspect's image has been captured on surveillance video, specifically for the arson fires that occurred on Monday, May 5<sup>th</sup>, 2012 and Tuesday, May 22<sup>nd</sup>, 2012 in the West Duluth Area. We are asking for the public's help in identifying this person.
