### **Traffic Advisory – Veteran's Day March**

**On Monday November 11<sup>th</sup>, 2013 the Veteran's Day March will be held in Downtown Duluth. It will start at 10:00 am, forming in front of the Depot on Michigan street, and after a brief ceremony it will proceed up 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue West to Superior Street, then eastbound in the lower lane to Lake Avenue, turning right and traveling down the Lake Avenue viaduct to Railroad Street where it turns right taking Railroad street to the North gate of the DECC. The March should be finished approximately 11:00 am.**

**To facilitate event setup, Michigan Street in front of the Depot will be closed to thru traffic starting at 09:00 am.**

**During the event, no traffic will be allowed in the eastbound lane of Superior Street from 5<sup>th</sup> Avenue West to Lake Avenue, in the south bound lane of Lake Avenue from Superior street to Railroad street, or on westbound Railroad Street from Lake Avenue to the DECC north gate.**

**Police will be blocking roadways and intersections as the March progresses toward the DECC.**

**Drivers are urged to use caution when driving in the area of the event.**
