Even the simple step of reducing your water heater temperature to 120 degrees (F) can help save energy.

Energy kits will also be given out to customers by Ecolibrium3 for completing the "energy obstacle course." The kits will have four energy conservation items, donated by ComfortSystems and MN Power, such as a furnace filter whistle, hot water temperature gauge card, low flow shower head, and bath faucet (1 gallon per minute) aerator.
