Play Equipment

Defined Play Area

The defined play area includes 1 composite play structure, to-fro swings (2 strap style, 2 bucket style), digger, talk tube and play panels. An adequate quantity of ground level components have been provided. *This is a good example of accessibility.*

Loose fill sand is used throughout the defined play area.

JQP, Inc. Recommends

Priority 2- Replace the loose fill sand with a surface material with a type that complies with ASTM 1292 for impact attenuation and ASTM 1951 for accessibility. *ADA 206.2.17*



Defined Play Area- Route

There is not currently an accessible route to the defined play area.

JQP, Inc. Recommends

Priority 1- Create an accessible route to the defined play area. *ADA 206.2.2*



Picnic



Picnic Tables- Northwest

There are 4 tables in the grass near the play equipment. Currently none of the tables provides a position with knee and toe clearance and there is not an accessible route.

JQP, Inc. Recommends

Priority 2- Create an accessible route to the picnic area.

Priority 3- Provide a picnic table that provides knee and toe clearance. *Recommended based on Draft Accessibility Guidelines for Outdoor Developed Areas 1011.4*

Bench

Bench

There are 4 benches located in the sand within the defined play area.

JQP, Inc. Recommends

Priority 3- Create an accessible route and clear ground space adjacent to the short end of the bench. *ADA 903.2*



Dog Bags



Dog Bags

There is currently a big dispenser provided for the collection of dog droppings. The dispenser is currently located in the grass near the picnic tables.

JQP, Inc. Recommends

Priority 3- Add an accessible route to the dog bags or relocate to an accessible location. *ADA 206.2.2*

Parking

Parking

There is a bump-out along Regent Street with room for approximately 10 vehicles parked parallel or 30 vehicles parked diagonal. (There is not striping.) There is not currently any designated accessible parking.

JQP, Inc. Recommends

Priority 2- Designate 1 accessible parking space. *ADA 208.2*

Priority 2- Stripe the accessible parking spaces to provide an 8' wide minimum space with an 8' wide minimum aisle. *MN1341 502.4.2*
