Wrap-up of This Week

- Waterproofing and sidewalk work continued in front of the Duluth Library. Foot traffic may enter the Library through Michigan Street.
- Parking lanes and amenity zones were installed between 5th Avenue W and 7th Avenue W.
- Minnesota Power crews installed power lines throughout the electrical duct banks.
- Crews brought the road to grade in preparation of additional concrete installation.
- Substantial completion date has been moved out a couple of weeks

What to Expect October 14-20

- Access to businesses and residences remain open.
- Weather permitting, the following concrete pouring will commence over the next two weeks:
- Flatwork crews will be pouring concrete roadway in phases, ensuring proper drying time.
- The portions of remaining sidewalk will continue to be installed.
- Stamped concrete in the intersections will be poured.
- Light poles will be installed.
- Crews will install roadway striping.
