### Word on the Street Weekly Update (October 9-14, 2018)

### Wrap-up of This Week

-Waterproofing and sidewalk work continued in front of the Duluth Library. Foot traffic may enter the Library through Michigan Street.

-Parking lanes and amenity zones were installed between 5th Avenue W and 7th Avenue W.

-Minnesota Power crews installed power lines throughout the electrical duct banks.

-Crews brought the road to grade in preparation of additional concrete installation.

-Substantial completion date has been moved out a couple of weeks

### What to Expect October 14-20

-Access to businesses and residences remain open.

-Weather permitting, the following concrete pouring will commence over the next two weeks:

-Flatwork crews will be pouring concrete roadway in phases, ensuring proper drying time.

-The portions of remaining sidewalk will continue to be installed.

-Stamped concrete in the intersections will be poured.

-Light poles will be installed.

-Crews will install roadway striping.
