Wrap-up of This Week

-Waterproofing and sidewalk work continued in front of the Duluth Library. Foot traffic may enter the Library through Michigan Street.

-Roadway concrete was poured between 5th Avenue W. and 7th Avenue W.

-Electrical crews began installing street lights and steel for traffic signals.

-Crews installed portions of southern sidewalk between 3rd Avenue W and 5th Avenue W.

-Alley access from maurices to 4th Ave West is open for those traveling north on the avenue-southbound travel onto 4th Ave West is not yet accessible

-Substantial completion date has been moved out a couple of weeks.

-Save the date: October 30 is planned celebration event at 10 AM - more details to come

What to Expect October 21 - 27

-Access to businesses and residences remain open.

-Weather permitting, the following concrete pouring will commence over the next week: Flatwork crews will finish

pouring concrete. The portions of remaining sidewalk will continue to be installed. Street lights and steel for traffic signals will continue to be installed. Crews will install roadway striping.
