Wrap-up of This Week

- -Superior Street between 3rd Avenue W. and 5th Avenue W was reopened to all traffic.
- -Thank you to all attendees our grand opening celebration! Check out photos of the event below.
- -Sidewalk work continued in front of the Duluth Library. Foot traffic may enter the Library through Michigan Street.
- -Electrical crews continued installing street lights and steel for traffic signals.
- -Crews installed large sections of sidewalk between 5rd Avenue W and 7th Avenue W.

What to Expect November 4 - 10

- -Access to businesses and residences remains open.
- -Front door access to the Duluth Library is scheduled for the end of next week with full road access expected the week of Nov. 12-16
- -Flatwork crews will continue pouring concrete sidewalks and curb ramps.
- -Street lights and steel for traffic signals will continue to be installed.
- -Crews will continue to stripe the roadway.
- -Detailed work will continue along the project.
