**Superior Street Construction - Word on the Street Update (April 25, 2019)**

**Wrap-up from the Previous Week**

- Crews finished removing bricks and pavement from East of Lake Avenue to West of 3rd Avenue East
- The wall between 1st Avenue East and 2nd Avenue East was removed to prepare for a new retaining wall

- Crews are working to install a temporary water main.
- Preparation work for the new retaining wall between 1st Avenue East and 2nd Avenue East will continue.
