Duluth, MN – Members of Governor Dayton's Mayors Tax Reform Advisory Group on Local Government Aid including Co-Chair Minneapolis Mayor R.T. Rybak and Duluth Mayor Don Ness, Revenue Commissioner Myron Frans, and other mayors and local officials from around the state will hold a press conference to support Governor Dayton's budget proposal to invest \$80 million in Local Government Aid (LGA). The group will also discuss a proposed change to the LGA formula designed by mayors and leaders from cities around the state. The proposed LGA changes provide stable, adequate funding for local governments and demonstrate the importance of a strong state and local partnership.
