The City has increased the wages to \$12 an hour, a \$1.50 bump from previous years. Employment will be from May to August.

Selected individuals may also have a chance to obtain a commercial drivers license and will learn new skills that build on individual and team success. ### Parks Laborer Overview

**PAY SCALE:** \$12.00/hour

**SUMMARY/PURPOSE:** To perform duties related to park maintenance.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Perform maintenance of lawns, trees, plants, flowers, and shrubs.
- Perform general cleaning and maintenance tasks of recreation facilities and parks.
- Pick up trash along roads and sidewalks.
- Sweep sidewalks, shovel snow, rake grass and leaves.
- Clean catch basins of leaves and other debris.

**REQUIREMENTS:**

- Must be age 18 or older.
- Must be able to lift and carry large items

### Streets Laborer Overview

**PAY SCALE:** \$12.00/hour

**SUMMARY/PURPOSE:** To perform duties related to street and traffic maintenance.

**ESSENTIAL DUTIES & RESPONSIBILITIES:**

- Patch streets with blacktop.
- Assist with placement of traffic control devices.
- Assist with traffic maintenance duties, such as street painting and sign installation.
- Pick up trash along roads.
- Assist in repairing parking meters.
