[Duluth, MN] The City of Duluth has 19 immediate openings on various boards, commissions, and authorities. Over 250 volunteers are currently serving on more than 30 Boards, Commissions, and Authorities that each work with City departments, City Councilors, and the public to serve the City.

All meetings of the City's boards and commissions are open to the public.
